Down under the struggle of Indian team continues and fissures seem to have developed inside the Team. Some strong measures are needed to be taken –soon IPL 2012 would be on and most of our debacle at England and Australia would tend to be forgotten. The 2012 Summer Olympic would be held in London in July. In the last version at Beijing in 2008, Abhinav Bindra won Gold in 10M airrifle shooting and the Indian contingent won 2 more bronze medals, making it easily the best performance in Olympics. Still it was sad for it was the first time since 1928 that Indian Men's hockey team failed to qualify. The present tournament being held in Delhi is touted as passport to Olympics and we hope that India does well here and then in Olympics.

In the Arabian Sea, closer to Kerala coast, Italian Mariners aboard an Italian flagged tanker Enrica Lexie fired at and killed 2 Indian fishermen which is creating diplomatic tussle. How can there by any diplomatic immunity and would jurisdictional issues get better of just compensation present a murky picture. Bomb blasts are nothing new but the bombing in New Delhi fixed to the car of Isreali defence attaché has a newer perspective of war elsewhere spilling on Indian soil. For long, flying on air, remained an elusive dream for the Indian middle class. The dawn of this century and a decade earlier, things changed much and slowly more were on air as more airlines facilitated low cost flying. Sadly all is not well and everyday there is news of the growing woes of Kingfisher Airlines, which does not augur well.

In promoting hygiene and keeping the environ cleaner, we have been maintaining the Public Convenience opposite to Temple tank at Triplicane. This was started in 2002 under the CM's Welfare scheme instituted by Hon'ble CM Ms J Jayalalithaa. SYMA CHILDFEST 2012

Child Fest Day 1 : 22nd Jan 2012 – Drawing Competitions

We have been conducting Child Fest for more than one and half a decade now. From last year, the venue has been the majestic inspiring red walls of the famous The Hindu Higher Secondary School, 149 Big Street, Triplicane – a great learning centre which has produced eminent scholars and successful personalities, transforming the lives of tens of thousands of people into responsible citizens for the cause of nature.

This year also, the competition was in 6 groups for students ranging from Lkg to 12th standard held at four different time – staggered to ensure that there were no two activities at any given time which helped us in crowd management. We had sent neatly designed invitations containing all details in a folder to 200 schools in the city of Chennai. We had kept flexboards advertising the event and the schedule. Details were available on our Website. Still some schools had not informed correct details to the parents, causing some disappointment to the students.

At 08:45am, the Programme was inaugurated by Dr P Balasubramaniam, present Head Master of Hindu High School and by Mrs Vanmathi, Dy Commissioner, Sri Parthasarathi Swami Devasthanam . The programme started with traditional invocation of Lord and lighting of 'kuthuvilakku' by the HM Balasubramaniam, Mrs Vanmathi, Dy Commnr, Smt Prema Krishnamohan - Soundarya Rathinamala, TJ Ramani – our Treasurer and R Vijaya raghavan, our Ex President. SYMA & Soundarya Rathinamala volunteers and students from Bharat Scouts ensured that everything was according to the plans drawn up earlier. The event was well coordinated by our Secretary R. Sanjeevi. Special thanks to Raghuraman for manning our office room. All the participating children were given prize and a Certificate commending their participation. We had close to 2000 students for dissipating and the cooperation of the Hindu School authorities and staff ensured that we were able to accommodate all the students and provide proper seats to all of them easily. In the end, the children and parents left with happiness writ large in their faces.

The competition for 9, 10, 11 & 12th was held at the hall in the 2nd floor; rest were held in the yellow building. The shamiana covering the play grounds provided good shelter against the sweltering heat of Sun and parents really appreciated the care taken by us. The results of the Drawing competition were immediately put up on our website which attracted thousands of hits. The talent and attitude of today's children is so encouraging and many of the drawings made us realize the innate talent that is present. We are very happy that we are able to provide a good platform for children showcasing their talent.

The action then shifted to the other venue – The Mylapore Fine Arts Club. This was our second successive year of conducting Childfest outside the precincts of Triplicane. On the day of Competition i.e., 29th Jan 2012, – SYMA volunteers and Soundarya Rathnamala were at the venue much before the inauguration. ferried to the venue in a van arranged. The venue looked colourful and the day started quite early. At around 0900 am, the day's events was inaugurated by Mr M. Balasubramanyam of Mangal Tirth Estates who expressed his happiness to be in the midst of SYMA group.

The First event was Singing of Carnatic songs. The stage at Mylapore Fine Arts had been the podium for great singers and this time, it was young students of various schools who actively participated. It was pleasant music to ears. The next event was Singing of Film songs which had enthusiastic participation. Culminating the event was the performance by the Judge who sung with ease in both male and female voices enthralling all those present. Alongside, the Quiz preliminary which was a written round consisting of 20 Questions was held for Group A (6thto 9th] and Group B [10th to 12th]. Most of the questions were topical and tested the knowledge of the events that captured headlines in newspapers. At 0100 noon - we had the finals of Quiz – first the A group, followed by Group B. The Quiz format was the brainchild of Brahma Associates thanks to N Rajaram for the full support extended from Oman. The Quiz was conducted by Yours Truly – the Editor S. Sampathkumar.

There was a very popular visitor amongst the audience. It was Mr. P.W.C.Davidar, I.A.S, Principal Secretary and Commissioner, Corporation of Chennai. We had earlier approached him to be our Chief Guest but he could not accede to our request owing to a high level meeting. It was indeed a great gesture on his part to attend the Child Fest and be in our midst for few minutes. It really raised our spirits.

Variety of instruments accompanied by performers started pouring in and at 02.30 pm we had the competition 'Instrument Fusion' which was a team event of 4 students per team. It was indeed a great variety. Then came the most colourful performance of Group Dance – group of 6 forming a team @ 03.30 pm. The crowd was filling in large numbers everywhere one can see painted children and anxious mothers. There were beautifully decorated animals, Various Lords -Hanumar, Buddha and more, National leaders like Bharathiyar, Gandhiji - science equipments and more - yes all beautiful children dressed and decorated capturing the attention and eyes of all. Unlike competitions elsewhere, at SYMA Fancy dress competition, there would be no dialogues or recitation of verses nor individual parading. Thirumazhisai Kannan ensured that photos of the well dressed children were taken and delivered on the spot. There was a huge contingent of SYMA volunteers readily available to do all chores. The group of Soundarya Rathnamala took care of the registration formalities and ensured distribution of certificates and gifts to all participants. Over all, it was a neatly organized colourful show.

At 0630 pm, we had the Prize Distribution Function. It was a great occasion as our Chief Guest for the evening was Mrs Santha Sheela Nair, IAS (Retd], Vice Chair Person, State Planning Commission, Govt. of Tamilnadu. Special Guests were Mr Ajay Ratnam, Cine Actor and Mr Dinesh Karthick, Cricketer. The function started with a prayer. Secretary, S. Sampathkumar compered the programme, welcoming everyone and introducing the Chief Guests. T.A. Sampathkumar, President spoke on the various activities of SYMA and on the vision of SYMA, on its growth, and the impact that Child Fest had made in city schools was also touched upon.

The State Planning Commission constituted in 1971 is the important advisory body recommending on various matters pertaining to development of the State. Mrs Santha Sheela Nair had held various important posts including – Principal Secretary to Govt., Commissioner of Corporation and Rehabilitation of Tamils in Sri Lanka. She is a person with vision and was instrumental in implementation of rain water harvesting across the State, a noble objective which SYMA also has professed and helped implementation in Triplicane. It was a great moment to have such a person as our distinguished Chief Guest and she spoke on the importance of planting more saplings which would grow to provide benefits to mankind.

Mr Ajay Rathnam is a well known artiste, having acted over 350 films in 5 languages. He endeared himself with his simplicity and friendly behaviour. He has now been in the field for over 25 years; he was too happy to be in the midst of children and spoke nicely to the children. Dinesh Karthick wields the willow better than speaking; he was instrumental in our winning the T20 in 2006 against SA. He has made more than 1000 runs in both Tests and One dayers and known to be a good glovesman. He inspired those children actively drawn to cricket.

SYMA owes its continuance to many good persons and besides the event sponsors Gold Winner and Media Associates CR Sridhar, we have the bounden duty to thank many of those without whose help conducting an event of this magnitude would not be possible. Ans : Cricket Law 38: describes Run out. Of the many ways, a batsman may be dismissed when backing up too far before the delivery stride. When the batsman leaves the popping crease before delivery, the bowler may attempt to run the non-striker out. This is clearly legal. The earliest of these type of out involved Vinoo Mankad and occurred during India's tour o Australia on 13 December 1947 in the second Test at Sydney. Mankad ran out Bill Brown when, in the act of delivering the ball, he held on to it and whipped the bails off with Brown well out of his crease. After this this type of run out came to be known as 'Mankaded'. There have been 4 instances of such outs in Tests and 3 in One dayers which includes : Briar Luckhurst by Greg Chappell; Grant Flower by Dipak Patel and Peter Kirsten by Kapil Dev. The illustrious Vinoo Mankad tool 162 wickets and scored 2109 runs in Tests. At Chennai way back in 1956 against New Zealand he hit 231 in an opening partnership of 413 with Pankaj Roy which stood as a record for 52 years.
