- X Veterans of SYMA fondly remember that day in July 2007 - with the blessings of our Emperumanar; with the guidance of Dr K Sridhar, firmly supported by Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Sankara Foundation, we made one significant step forward of starting a full fledged clinical laboratory. The Lab is named after PV Rama Iyengar & Smt. Suganthavalli – whose family members donated funds and medical equipments for the lab. Mr KV Kumar (KVK Builders) MrRajagopal of RR Construction helped us in creating necessary infrastructure for the lab. On 8th July 2006, at the famed MahakaviSubrahmanyaBharathiyarillam, our Educational aid function was conducted. The then Commissioner, Corporation of Chennai Mr Rajesh B Lakhoni, adorned the podium. The Chief guest was Mr Mohammed Abdul Ali Azim Jah, Prince of Arcot - and on the dais, our lab was inaugurated. We have been providing medical assistance to poor charging a very low amount at this lab and have been supported by many philanthropists in running this.

Now after a decade, we have taken another firm and positive step aimed at achieving more reliability and recognition in medical field. Medall Healthcare Pvt. Ltd (MEDALL) is South India's largest chain of medical diagnostic services providing diagnostic services, both Pathology and Radiology imaging. This chain of diagnostic service enjoys great recognition by their service and quality. We have now tied-up with Medall and from October 2017 onwards the samples collected at our lab, is being tested and reportbeing issued by Medall enhancing the reputation and reliability of the medical analysis.

This shift means some more expenditure in administering the lab, yet we have happily taken the plunge. The response is very encouraging.. In the coming months, we expect Doctors directing the poor to utilise our services.Our special thanks are due to our member Mr.S.Parthasarathi (Gill) for his initiative in bringing this about.

Every year on our Independence Day, we hoist our National flag at our centre and proceed to have cataract detection camp. This year too, it was conducted in association with Sankara Eye Hospital,Pammal. Their great work has resulted in providing vision to more than 2.50 lakhs of people. We are ever thankful to the ever helpful officials of the hospital and Mr J Babu for all their support.We have come a long way since 1989 when our medical services were launched in a small street corner at Peyalwar Street ~ many our volunteers have striven so hard ensuring that pleasant and quality service is extended to poor and needy. Of the many people involved – we recall and remember the passionate services of dear Mr. KE Raghavan who sadly left us for heavenly abode on 25.8.2007. Every year we remember him on 25th of August. This year on Independence day - around 130 people were screened, 11 persons were selected, of them 9 were taken to Sri Sankara Eye Hospital, Pammal on the same day. Cataract surgery was done free for them, later, they were brought back to Triplicane in a van arranged by SYMA. SYMA members went to the hospital a day later, met those who underwent eye surgery, providing them words of comfort.

Another significant event in that camp was release of our own 'Syma Song' which was penned by Mr. KV Sridhar, sung, conceptualized and set to music by Mr. Rajamani, Mrs. Aravindha Krishna, Gopi, recorded at Sri Vishnu Audio, Mylapore. #### **GROWTH:**

- X Our cherished project in the field of Education 'SYMA Growth' has been prospering and has marched towards 10th year of success. In realising our unsaturated desire for improving the society, there is need for shaping the children and inculcating in them the good qualities, making them responsible citizens. The classes for the present academic year started in June 2017 with invocation to Sri Parthasarathi Perumal. The students were initially screened and interaction had with parents ensuring that the most deserving were selected on economic criteria. The Centre is run on all days from 6-8 pm in the evening and on Sundays @ 10-12 am and has +2 Commerce, + Science Group; X standard – Tamil and X Std English medium – each having around 30 students.
- X Examination results keep us on tenterhooks. The students have done well in their exams during the year 2018-19. In Plus Two Examinations, Commerce & Science Group students (43), we had 100% students passing the Board Exams. 10 of our students obtained more than 400 marks out of 500.. Growth topper was 545 out of 600 marks.
- X In 10th Std the students percentage of pass is 100%. Out of English medium ---students -- students have secured more than 400 marks out of 500. In Tamil medium out of -- students - -- students have scored more than 400 marks. Growth topper in X std secured --- out of 500.





- X In the month of May 2018, applications were distributed for the next academic year (2018-19) and we conducted a personal interview for each student who was accompanied with their parents. We have finalized the students based on the economic criteria and the Tenth year of SYMA Growth was launched during 1st week of June.
- X We have around 120 students in +2 Commerce, + 2 Science Group; X standard – Tamil and X Std English medium – going by the demand, we are contemplating on putting another section in X English medium.
- X Our special thanks to M/s Experis IT and Manpower Inc for their sponsorship for the present academic year. Gratitude is due to Mr PV Venkatesan of Manpower also. On ----- - Saraswathipooja day, special prayers were conducted at the school premises followed up by pooja at our office premises.
