Medical Services:

We are happy to share that we have served 13792 (7775) patients at our medical centre premises.

For an Organisation started with the objective of keeping the environ clean and civic activities, our journey in medical service has been mentored, guided, and properly steered by Dr K Sridhar. A renowned Plastic surgeon, earlier member of Planning Commission of the State, presently - Director & Senior Consultant - Plastic Surgery Institute of Caraniofacial, Aesthetic and Plastic Surgery - has always provided us the correct advice. Every time we think of our services in Medical field, we remember him and he was instrumental in our setting up the Ultra Scan centre too.

We are thankful to the Doctors who have been rendering medical advice to the patients. We appreciate the services of medical fraternity of Dr. K S Vidyalakshmi, Dr. Monisha Ramesh, Dr. Suganthi, Dr. Murali, Dr. Rajasekar, Dr. Divya Ganesan, Dr. Janani, Dr. Saravanapriyan, Dr. Senthilnathan, Dr. Dineshkumar, Dr. Reena, Dr. Ibad Shah, M/s Pammal Sankara Eye Hospital and Mr. Vignesh. We are also thankful to the management of pammal sankara eye hospital for operating a OP clinic at our medical centre charging only Rs.50/- for eye consultation & testing.

- On 24th July 2022 We have conducted Mega Covid-19 Booster Camp at our medical centre in association with Greater Chennai Corporation. Over 180 individuals benefitted from our camp which was appreciated by local public and Corporation Commissioner Shri. Bedi sent his appreciation for the conduct of camp effectively.
- On 25th Aug 2022 We have distributed spectacles to 22+ persons remembering Mr. KE Raghavan, who left us in 2007. EDUCATION:

Our cherished project in the field of Education 'SYMA Growth' has been prospering and has marched towards 15th year of success. In realising our unsaturated desire for improving the society, there is need for shaping the children and inculcating in them the good qualities, making them responsible citizens. The classes for the academic year started in July 2022 with invocation to Sri Parthasarathi Perumal. The students were initially screened and interaction had with parents ensuring that the most deserving were selected on economic criteria. The Tuition Centre is run on all days from 6-8 pm in the evening and on Sundays @ 10-12 pm and has +2 Commerce, + Science Group; X standard – English medium – each having around 30 students. X Examination results keep us on tenterhooks. The students have done well in their exams during the year 2022-23. In Plus Two Examinations, Commerce & Science Group (24 students), we had 100% of students passing the Board Exams. Growth topper was with 511/600 marks. In 10th Std (28 students), Growth topper in X std secured 445 out of 500.

In the month of June, applications were distributed for the academic year (2022-23) and we conducted a personal interview for each student who was accompanied with their parents. We have finalized the students based on the economic criteria and the 15th year of SYMA Growth was launched during 1st week of July.

On Saraswathi pooja day, special prayers were conducted at the school premises followed up by pooja at our office premises. Sri Devarajabattar, Chinnamuraimirasu of Sri Parthasarathi swami temple conducted the pooja and blessed all of us. Sri NS Rangaswamibattar and Sri Deva battar have been conducting special poojas for our welfare and we are ever thankful to them.
