Our tuition center "GROWTH" has witnessed significant progress over the years, evolving from humble beginnings into a well-established educational institution.



- ★ On 10th January 2025, Vaikunda Ekadashi medical camp was organized at our medical centre premises to conduct random blood sugar tests. Around 250 individuals availed themselves of this service to check their sugar levels.



- ★ On 2nd March 2025, a comprehensive medical camp was conducted for Urbaser workers at the SYMA Medical Centre in Triplicane. Out of 164 workers, 136 were screened for eye health, resulting in 67 being prescribed spectacles and 6 being advised to undergo cataract surgery. The camp also included Dental and Oral Screening, Gynecologist Consultation, General Physician Checkup, and blood sample collection for testing Random Sugar, Thyroid Profile, and Hemoglobin levels.

National Days

15th August 2024



- ★ On the occasion of India's Independence Day, H. H. Sri. Sri. Vishwa Prasanna Theertha Swamiji hoisted the national flag at our premises. An Eye Camp was conducted in collaboration with Sri Sankara Eye Hospital, Pammal. A total of 163 individuals were screened. Among them, 12 were identified for cataract surgery, which was performed free of cost at the hospital. After the procedures, they were brought back to Triplicane. Additionally, 42 people were prescribed spectacles.

A special function was held at the SYMA Medical Centre to distribute the 42 prescribed spectacles from the earlier Eye Camp. Mr. K. E.
