Bone Mineral Density Camp

- * 8th August 2025 - SYMA in association with Government Omandurar medical college and TNOA conducted a camp for people of age 50 and above to check their bone scan at our medical centre premises. Around 70 people were benefitted.

Eye Camp

SYMA - Urbaser – Special Medical Camp – 15th March 2026

- * On Sunday, 15th March 2026, SYMA — backed by 49 years of unbroken community service — partnered with Urbaser to organise a dedicated health screening camp for Urbaser’s frontline sanitation workforce and the surrounding neighbourhood at SYMA Medical Centre, Triplicane. Supported by IAOH, AINU, and Karpaga Vinayaga Institute of Medical Sciences, the camp was led by Dr.Khavya and her medical team. The camp began at 8:30 AM and offered a full suite of preventive health checks at no cost.



The camp at a glance:

- * 100+ beneficiaries - Urbaser workers and local residents - received comprehensive free screening in a single morning
- * 8 health services delivered under one roof - from basic vitals to kidney-function blood tests
- * 12+ medical staff and 20+ SYMA volunteers ensured smooth, caring service throughout

Services provided included:

- * Dental Screening & Oral Cavity Examination
- * Blood Pressure (BP) Monitoring
- * Blood Sugar Test
- * Height, Weight & BMI Assessment
- * SpO₂ (Oxygen Saturation) Measurement
- * Serum Creatinine Test (Kidney Function)
- * CBC Blood Test
- * Personalised Doctor Consultations - one-on-one, unhurried, attentive.
- * The camp enabled early risk detection for diabetes, hypertension, and kidney disease. Sanitation workers who rarely make it to the front of any queue - including the one at a doctor's clinic - received the attention and care they deserve. Workers in Urbaser hi-vis vests queued alongside elderly neighbours, and young medical staff bent over chairs to examine every patient with care and patience.
- * This camp exemplifies SYMA's belief that preventive health is not a luxury - it is the single most cost-effective investment a community can make. SYMA and Urbaser have together demonstrated that when organisations align purpose with action, change reaches the people who need it most. We look forward to making this an annual fixture larger, better resourced, and reaching even further into the community.
